Prof. Dr. Badawi Ismail is Professor in Heritage Preservation and Archaeological Restoration at the South Valley University of Luxor, Qena (Egypt), where he was Dean of the Faculty of Arcaheology. His research is focused on studying the risk of deterioration and new methods for preventive conservation of Cultural Heritage. He is consultant for the Egyptian Ministry of Culture and the Ministry of Antiquities, in particular as expert advisor for the establishment of the Grand Egyptian Museum and the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. He has held administrative and scientific positions at the Ministry of Higher Education.
